- What did you like best?
 - ***Let them choose their favorite exercises for the last day of class.***

7 KEY QUESTIONS FOR THE TEACHER/SITE COORDINATOR:

- Did we meet our goals? How/not?
- What did you find most useful?
- What worked?
- What didn't work?
- What could we have done differently?
- Has the residency influenced your teaching practice? In what way?
 - ***Share how it has influenced your teaching practice as a teaching artist.***
- How have your students grown or changed?
- How have classroom dynamics changed?
